SECTION 1: NOTICE TO TENDERERS

1. INVITATION TO TENDER

- a) Responses to this Tender [hereinafter referred to as a **Tender**] are requested from persons, companies, close corporations or enterprises [hereinafter referred to as a Tenderer]. Only those tenderers who are registered with the Construction Industry Development Regulations, with a designation of ~~7CE or higher or~~ **7GB or higher** class of construction work, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

- "The CIDB Standard for Developing Skills through Infrastructure Contracts, published in Government Gazette 43495 dated 3 July 2020 is applicable to this project".

And,

- "The CIDB Standard for Indirect Targeting for Enterprise Development through Construction works Contracts, published in Gazette Notice No.36190 of 25 February 2013 is applicable to this project".

Note: Each of the Standards above, where applicable to this tender, have a related fee which is contained in the Bill of Quantities / Activity Schedule. Additionally, a CIDB BUILD fee at the rate of 0,2% of the tendered value, up to a maximum of R2,000,000.00 is included in the Bill of Quantities/ Activity Schedule.

Stage One: Eligibility: Administrative & Substantive Responsiveness

Step 1 – Compulsory clarification meeting:

An authorised representative of the tendering entity or a representative of a tendering entity that intends to form a Joint Venture (JV) must attend the compulsory clarification meeting in terms C2.7. Attendance at the compulsory clarification meeting.

Any tenderer that fails to meet the stipulated pre-qualifying criteria will be regarded as an unacceptable tender.

Step 2 – CIDB Grading

- a) Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, designation of ~~7CE or higher or~~ **7GB or higher** class of construction work, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

- c) Joint Venture (JV)

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders subject to the following:

1. every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB;
2. the lead partner has a contractor grading designation of not lower than one level below the required class of construction works under consideration and possesses the required recognition status; and
3. the combined Contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a *Contractor* grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a ~~7CE or higher or~~ **7GB or higher** class of construction work or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25(1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations.

The tenderer shall provide a copy of its unincorporated joint venture agreement.

- the combined Contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a Contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a ~~7CE or higher or~~ **7GB or higher** class of construction work or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25(1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations.
- the Contractor shall provide the employer with a copy of its signed joint venture agreement;
- and in the event that the joint venture is an 'Incorporated Joint Venture' the Memorandum of Incorporation to be provided within 4 (four) weeks of the Contract Date.
