

SCOPE OF SERVICES



1. Project Overview

Transnet Port terminal (TPT) core business is the handling of bulk and break-bulk commodities, either entering or exiting via Richards Bay harbour premises. A network of conveyors, storage areas. Transfer house and galleries forms the bulk of the infrastructure for the port operations. In addition, fleet, ship up —loaders, mobile stackers, re-claimers and ship loaders are some of the large equipment that is used by the terminal to handle cargo.
