The description mentions 20's but the pack size column refers to 100's.	Please note that the required pack size for Flucloxacillin 250mg capsules is 100 capsules.
2				(200ml) Zinc 5mg/ selenium/ vitamin c syrup 200ml - Products containing zinc and selenium for children have been recalled by SAHPRA. We will therefore be unable to place a bid on this SKU. Please refer to attached communication in this regard.	Bidders may quote on Zn-Ped Syrup 200ml as an alternative to Zinplex Junior 200ml, subject to product availability and compliance with applicable regulatory requirements.



3				<p>Pantoprazole 40mg capsules 14's - A pack size of 14's is requested on the RFQ as well as a dosage form of capsules. This is not available in the market. Pantoloc is available in 28's and as enteric coated tablets. The bid will therefore be placed according to those specifications but the spec deviations will be indicated on the RFQ.</p>	<p>Please proceed with quoting Pantoloc 40mg enteric coated tablets in pack sizes of 28's. This alternative specification is acceptable.</p>
4				<p>The RFQ also requests a cost per trip to the train station. To put a unit price of a trip, please can you provide a list of which train stations the successful bidder will need to deliver to and the frequency if possible?</p>	<p>Please note that the rate per trip will be calculated based on the distance per kilometre from the supplier's warehouse to the various train stations across the country where the trains may be scheduled to operate. As the operational schedule is subject to change, a fixed list of stations and delivery frequencies cannot be confirmed at this stage. Deliveries will be required on an as-and-when-needed basis in line with operational, patient needs and order requirements.</p>



5				<p>Please can I also confirm that the unit price is the price of a pack of that product and therefore the total price will be the price per pack multiplied by the total quantity required?</p>	<p>Yes, that is correct.</p>
6				<p>Also, the bid documents mention that delivery time is essential. Please can I ask what lead time will be expected, i.e. from the time of placing the order to the time that the order must be delivered to the respective train station?</p>	<p>The required lead times are as stipulated in the RFQ: Standard orders must be delivered within 7 working days from date of order placement. Emergency orders must be delivered within 24 hours of order placement.</p>
