3 PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT PREQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

3.1 Minimum B-BBEE level

Transnet has set a minimum B-BBEE threshold for participation in this RFQ process. The minimum B-BBEE threshold in this instance is a B-BBEE Level 2. Respondents who do not have at least this B-BBEE status or higher will be disqualified.

3.2 **Exempted Micro Enterprises**

Transnet has set a prequalification criterion that only Exempted Micro Enterprises (EMEs) may participate in this RFQ process. A bid that fails to meet this pre-qualifying criterion will be regarded as an unacceptable bid.

4 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

- 5.2 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.
- 5.3 Unless otherwise expressly stated, all Proposals furnished pursuant to this RFP shall be deemed to be offers. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.

6 JOINT VENTURES OR CONSORTIUMS

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [JV] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If at the time of the bid submission such a JV or consortium agreement has not been concluded, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split of business and the responsibilities of each party. In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

Respondents are to note that for the purpose of Evaluation, a JV will be evaluated based on one consolidated B-BBEE score card (a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate) as per the B-BBEE Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 preference point scoring.

7 COMMUNICATION

- 7.3 Respondents are to note that changes to its submission will not be considered after the closing date.
- 7.4 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFP between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 7.5 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.

8 CONFIDENTIALITY

All information related to this RFP is to be treated with strict confidence. In this regard Respondents are required to certify that they have acquainted themselves with the Non-Disclosure Agreement. All information related to a subsequent contract, both during and after completion thereof, will be treated with strict confidence. Should the need however arise to divulge any information related to this RFP or the subsequent contract, written approval must be obtained from Transnet.

9 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Service provider**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

10 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

11 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFP and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 11.1 modify the RFP's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- 11.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- 11.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 11.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 11.7 cancel the bid process;



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- 11.8 validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;
- 11.9 request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;

- 11.12 to award the business to the next ranked bidder, provided that he/she is still prepared to provide the required Goods/Services at the quoted price, should the preferred bidder fail to sign or commence with the contract within a reasonable period after being requested to do so. Under such circumstances, the validity of the bids of the next ranked bidder(s) will be deemed to remain valid, irrespective of whether the next ranked bidder(s) were issued with a Letter of Regret. Bidders may therefore be requested to advise whether they would still be prepared to provide the required Goods/Services at their quoted price, even after they have been issued with a Letter of Regret.

Note that Transnet will not reimburse any Respondent for any preparatory costs or other work performed in connection with its Proposal, whether or not the Respondent is awarded a contract.

12 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. A material deviation from the Standard terms or conditions could result in disqualification.

13 SECURITY CLEARANCE

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the Goods/Services and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of **CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET**. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

14 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Respondents must register on the CSD prior to submitting their bids. Business may not be awarded to a Respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD.



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For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

15 TAX COMPLIANCE

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

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SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1 BACKGROUND

Lighthouses Located in Northern KZN are used as Aids to Navigation for Maritime traffic operating along the Coastline and is critical to safety of navigation in the area.

The Lighthouses are strategically located and in some cases are in Rural areas that are prone to vandalism and security related incidents.

This service relates to the placing of security Guards at Lighthouse locations in Northern KZN so as to safe guard Transnet owned assets, equipment and personnel with a view to ensure continued operation of the Lighthouses.

Security guards will be expected to be deployed in accordance with a scheduled shift pattern so that the Stations are not left unattended. Supervision of these deployed guards as well as all necessary equipment is also required in accordance with standard practices and procedures in the security industry.

2 EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

Whereas Transnet is seeking a partner(s) to provide security guards at Lighthouses located in Northern KZN for a period of 6 months, it also seeks to improve its security services processes for providing these services to its end user community throughout its locations.

3 SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 Provide 2 x grade C security Guards per 12-hour shift at Cape St Lucia Lighthouse.

 Provide all equipment and uniforms.
- 3.2 Provide 1 x grade C security Guards per 12-hour shift at Richards Bay Lighthouse.
 - Provide all equipment and uniforms.
- 3.3 Provide 1 x grade C security Guards per 12-hour shift at LNS Richards Bay Workshop.
 - Provide all equipment and uniforms.
- 3.4 Provide 1 x grade C security Guards per 12-hour shift at Richards Bay Buoy Yard.
 - Provide all equipment and uniforms.
- 3.5 Provide 2 x grade C security Guards per 12-hour shift at Durnford Lighthouse.
 - Provide all equipment and uniforms.


