MINUTE	DESCRIPTION OF DISCUSSION		
1.	Welcome – Thulane Msibi		
1.1	Welcome & Introductions		
	Thulane opened the meeting by welcoming everyone, and gave a brief de-		
	scription of the project that was presented on the meeting.		
	Thulane explained that the session shall consist of three presentations, the		
	first part will be the SCM Department, followed by the Supplier Development		
	and lastly the Technical Department. Thereafter, questions shall be addressed		

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	at the end of each presentation. Bidders where also requested to forward	
	their questions via emails before the stipulated communication date as	
	indicated on the RFP document. Bidders were also informed that questions	
	and answers shall be posted on two portals i.e., Transnet etenders and Na-	
	tional Treasury's etenders.	
2.	Rules of engagement	TM
	Thulane took the bidders through the rules of engagement and highlighted	
	that this is a non-compulsory briefing session.	
	Thulane also highlighted those questions and answers are shared with all	
	the bidders once SCM has consolidated the entire information received be-	
	fore COB on Wednesday, 14 <sup>th</sup> December 2022.	
3.	SCM Presentation:	TM
	Thulane then took the bidders through the SCM requirements which	
	includes the closing date and time, Submission of Documents, Evaluation	
	Methodology, Eligibility Criteria, Non-Disclosure Agreement, Master Agree-	
	ment, Communications, and Award Methodology.	
	Reuben (Bidder) Requested that TPT considers changing the submission	
	of documents from etenders to the documents being hand delivered since	
	the quantity and size of the documents required is relatively huge.	
	Sikhonzele indicated that there's currently no window opened to allow for	
	hand deliveries, after the introduction of the etenders portal TPT is no	
	longer allowed to consider the physical delivery of tender documents.	
	Reuben (bidder) asked if companies that are not in the tyre industry can	
	be able to apply for the tender.	
	Thulane answered that any bidder is allowed to tender for this project pro-	
	vided they meet TPT's requirements.	
	No further questions were received from the bidders regarding the SCM	
	presentation	

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4.	Supplier Development	SG
	<ul> <li>Sikhonzele presented the supplier development and took the bidder through the mandatory Sub-Contracting requirements of EME's or QSE's which are at least 51% black owned, 51% Black Youth owned, 51% black women owned, 51% owned by black Person with disabilities, 51% ownership of someone who's living in Township or Rural areas.</li> <li>Sikhonzele also highlighted that bidder need to submit a valid BBBEE/Sworn Affidavit for the Main and Sub-Contractor including Job creation requirements of the tender.</li> <li>Wynand (Bidder) asked if the 30% Sub-Contracting is per region or it's for the total duration of the contract should they elected to bid for more than one region?</li> <li>Sikhonzele answered that the 30% Sub-Contracting is calculated on the total contract value.</li> </ul>	
5.	Technical Presentation	MM
	<ul> <li>Mbali began the presentation by taking the bidders through the Scope Works where she discussed the Supply of New Tyres, Re-Treading of Tyres, Repairs of Tyres &amp; Rims, Condition Monitoring of Tyre Rims, Tyre Management, and onsite inflations service using bakkies.</li> <li>Mbali further touched on the vehicle and labour requirements per region.</li> <li>Mbali proceeded with taking the bidders through the Technical Evaluation Criteria highlighting the Eligibility Criteria, Calibration Certificates, Lead Times, References, Quality of Re-Treading, and the Objective Criteria.</li> <li>Mbali concluded her presentation with the Pricing Schedule and took the bidders through the structure of the Pricing Schedule and how they are expected to quote for their Region(s) of interest.</li> <li>Wynand (Bidder) requested an Excel pricing schedule so it's easy for the Bidders to quote and accurately calculate price.</li> <li>Thulane responded by saying that SCM will do an internal consultation before taking the final decision, which will be communicated to bidders in</li> </ul>	

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	due time.	
	• Wynand (Bidder) asked how is Transnet going to differentiate between	
	good brands and bad brands considering that the tender will be awarded	
	based on Price and BBBEE.	
	Thulane Transnet is not allowed to include brand names in the specifica-	
	tion, and also indicated that Transnet has included various criterions on the	
	document to ensure they mitigate the risk of awarding to a bidder that will	
	provide Transnet with low quality tyres. In addition, Transnet will conduct a	
	due diligence exercise to further mitigate this risk.	
	• Paul (Bidder) asked how is Transnet going to mitigate the risk of award-	
	ing to the cheapest bidders considering that they might be offering poor	
	quality products.	
	Sikhonzele Responded by saying that Transnet has conducted a market	
	analysis to determine the market related rate for the kind of products	
	required by Transnet. This market analysis will give Transnet the view of	
	how much are the required products and services are being offered in the	
	market.	
	Akshay (Bidder) asked how Transnet will make the determination to	
	either use the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system since they have both	
	been included on the tender document.	
	• <b>Thulane</b> responded and said that Transnet will consider the lowest	
	acceptable bid per Region and therefore adopt the appropriate preference	
	point system.	
	• Reuben (Bidder) asked what star rating is required? What tread depth is	
	required? What speed ratio is required, what load capacity is required? and	
	indicated that there's a lot of technical aspect not included on the specifica-	
	tion.	
	• <b>Mbali</b> answered that all that information has been included on Transnet's	
	pricing schedule.	
	• Thulane requested Reuben to put his question in writing so that it can be	
	properly addressed by the technical team and shared with all the prospec-
