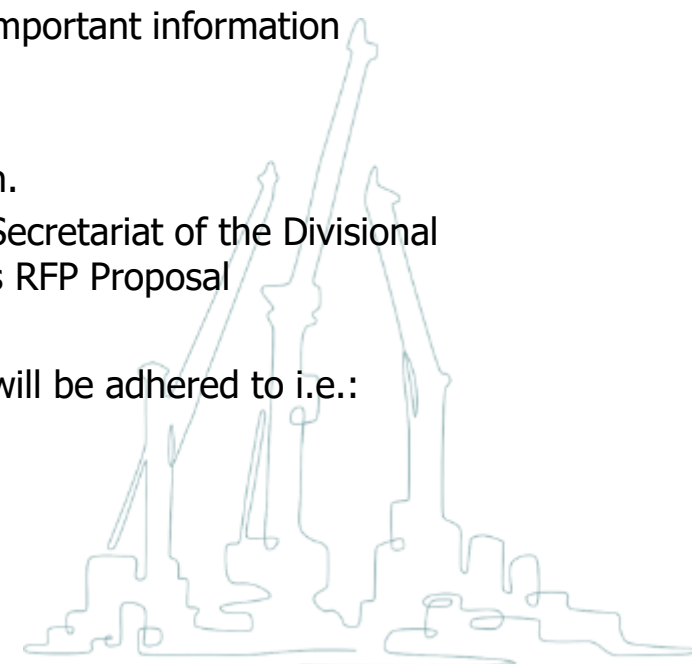

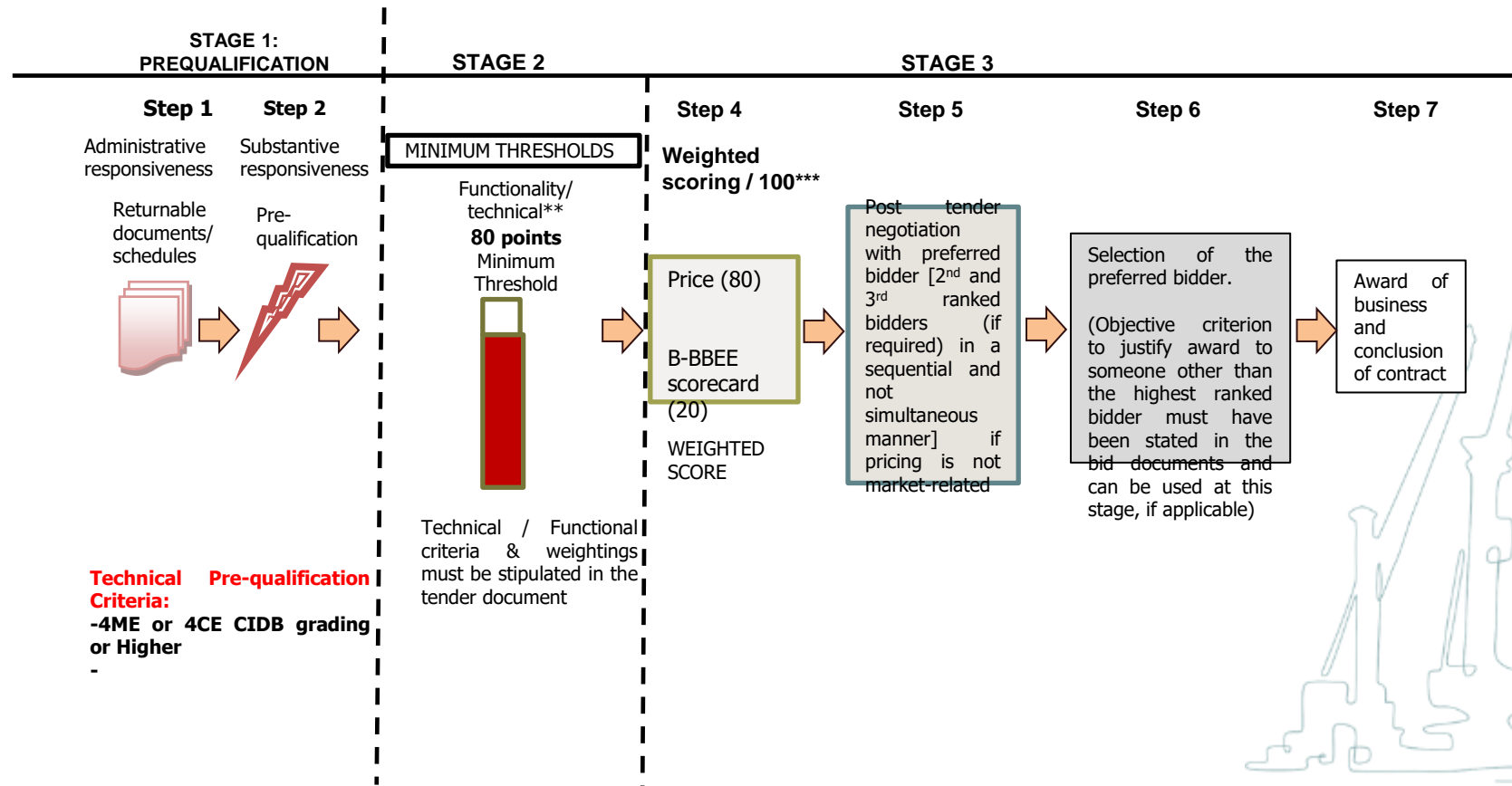

# Procurement process briefing (Overview)

- ☐ The tender was advertised on the Transnet Rail Engineering website/portal, National Treasury and CIDB.
- ☐ The RFQ closing date and time is the **09 May 2023** at **10:00am** promptly. Please ensure that you abide with the deadline. Late submissions will be disqualified.
- ☐ For bid submission. (**Log on to the Transnet e-Tender Submission Portal platform website (<https://transnetetenders.azurewebsites.net/>) Refer to Section 1.**)
- ☐ Bidders are requested to remain for the entire duration of the briefing session as important information pertaining to the RFP will be presented

# Procurement process (Evaluation Methodology cont.)

## Step 1: Test for Administrative Responsiveness

Whether the Bid has been lodged on time

The test for administrative responsiveness will include the following:

Administrative responsiveness check

- Whether the Bid has been lodged on time
- Whether the Bid contains a priced offer
- Whether the Bid materially complies with the scope and/or specification given
- Whether any general pre-qualification criteria set by Transnet have been met

NB: The test for administrative responsiveness [step one] must be passed for a Respondent's proposal to progress to step two for further pre-qualifications



# Procurement process briefing (Evaluation Methodology cont.)

## Step 2: Test for Substantive Responsiveness

### 2.1 Substantive Responsiveness

Only those tenderers who satisfy the following eligibility criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

1. Eligibility with regards to attendance at the compulsory clarification meeting:

An authorised representative of the tendering entity or a representative of a tendering entity that intends to form a Joint Venture (JV) must attend the compulsory clarification meeting in terms C2





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Only those tenderers who satisfy the following eligibility criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

Eligibility in terms of the **Construction Industry Development Board: 4ME or 4CE or higher**

- a) Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so registered prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, designation **of 4ME or 4CE or higher** class of construction works, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.



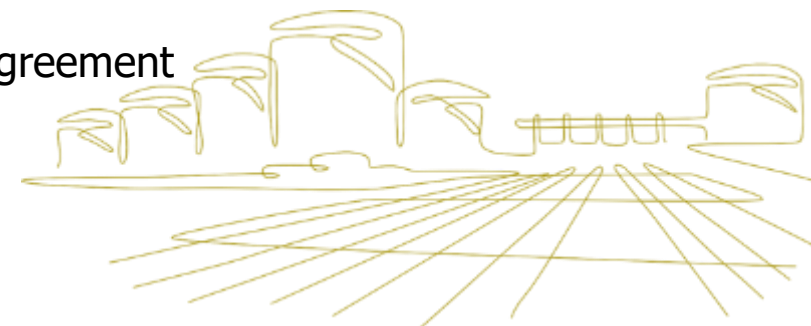
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## Joint Venture (JV)

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders subject to the following:

1. every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB;
2. the lead partner has a contractor grading designation of not lower than one level below the required class of construction works under consideration and possesses the required recognition status; and
3. the combined Contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Regulations is equal to or higher than a Contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a **4ME or 4CE** or higher or higher class of construction work or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25(1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations

The tenderer shall provide a certified copy of its signed joint venture agreement



# Procurement process briefing (Evaluation Methodology cont.)

## Step 3: Technical Evaluation

- **Minimum Threshold 80% for Functional /Technical Criteria**

- ☐ Compliance to specification - 30
- ☐ Project Organogram, Management & CV's -30
- ☐ Programme - 30
- ☐ Previous Experience/projects of similar nature - 10

- ❖ *Any tenderer that fails to meet the stipulated pre-qualifying criteria will be regarded as an unacceptable tender.*
- ❖ **The minimum threshold for technical/functionality [Step three] must be met or exceeded for a Respondent's Proposal to progress to next step evaluation.**
- ❖ **The Technical team to take bidders through the Technical evaluation**



# Procurement process briefing (Evaluation Methodology cont.)

## Step 4: Price and B-BBEE

- Only bidders who have met the predetermined threshold will proceed to stage 4
- Points will be allocated as follows:
- Price (80); and
- B-BBEE (20)

- Page 13 The closing time for submission of tender offers is: There was a typing error is supposed to be 2023 not 2022.

- The bidder must submit their Tax clearance certificate.
