	Referring to above mentioned tender and ADDENDUM NO. 01, dd 18 July 2024. We are writing to further explain the reason why we requested for an extension of the closing date. We have carefully reviewed the current tender timeline and, despite the closing date has been extended to 21 August 2024, we believe that the period given remains unrealistic for the magnitude of the project to be carried out during the summer holiday period. We have outlined the reasons for this request below:	Extension has been granted, due date for clarifications is now 21 September 2024. Tenderers must refer to Addendum 2 as published on 08 August 2024.
1	 Customised Design Requirements: Although the requested design is similar to your Grab hopper dredger "Italeni", the customised nature of this project necessitates treating it as a customised new building project. Such projects demand significant time and resources. Design Review and Compliance: Reviewing and ensuring compliance with today's rules and regulations requires 2-4 weeks. Internal Department Inputs: Gathering detailed input from our engineering and production departments regarding capacity, pricing, and planning is essential and requires 2-4 weeks. Supply Chain Coordination: Collecting information from our supply chain regarding design, pricing, and delivery times is a 6-8 week process. Regulatory Compliance: Incorporating feedback from our tax, legal, and treasury teams to review all returnable tender documents and ensure local regulation compliance is critical and requires 2-4 weeks. Internal Approval Process: Securing internal approval through our corporate governance process will take 2-4 weeks. Risk Management: Allowing insufficient time forces all parties to account for additional risk budgets. Summer Holiday Period: The summer holiday period significantly limits capacity until the end of August for both our suppliers and main contractors.
