[Respondents to provide own transportation and accommodation]. The briefing session will start punctually and information will not be repeated for the benefit of Respondents arriving late.

- 1.1 Despite the briefing session being non-compulsory, Transnet nevertheless encourages all Respondents to attend. Transnet will not be held responsible if any Respondent who did not attend the **non- compulsory** session subsequently feels disadvantaged as a result thereof.
- 1.2 Respondents are encouraged to bring a copy of the RFP to the site meeting and RFP briefing.
- 1.3 The **non-compulsory** briefing session will take place face to face.

3 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

4 **RFP INSTRUCTIONS**

- 4.1 Please sign documents [sign, stamp and date the bottom of each page] before uploading them on the system. The person or persons signing the submission must be legally authorised by the respondent to do so.
- 4.2 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.
- 4.3 Unless otherwise expressly stated, all Proposals furnished pursuant to this RFP shall be deemed to be offers. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.
- 4.4 Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. Subject only to clause 15 [Alterations made by the Respondent to Bid Prices] of the General Bid Conditions, paragraph 12 below (Legal Review) and Section 6 of the RFP, alterations, additions or deletions must not be made by the Respondent to the actual RFP documents.

5 JOINT VENTURES OR CONSORTIUMS

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [**JV**] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If at the time of the bid submission such a JV or consortium agreement has not been concluded, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split of business and the responsibilities of each party. In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

Respondents are to note that for the purpose of Evaluation, a JV will be evaluated based on one consolidated B-BBEE score card (a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level verification certificate) Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the specific goals requirements in accordance with the table indicated in Table 3.2 of the specific goals Claim Form.

6 COMMUNICATION

6.1 For specific queries relating to this RFP, an RFP Clarification Request Form should be submitted onto the system and to [**Susan DeJongh**] before **12:00 pm on 19 July 2024**, substantially in the form set out



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in Section 8 hereto. In the interest of fairness and transparency, Transnet's response to such a query will be published on the e-tender portal and Transnet website.

- 6.2 After the closing date of the RFP, a Respondent may only communicate with the DBAC Secretariat [Susan DeJongh], at telephone number (021) 940 3340, email <u>susan.dejongh@transnet.net</u> on any matter relating to its RFP Proposal.
- 6.3 Respondents are to note that changes to its submission will not be considered after the closing date.
- 6.4 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFP between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 6.5 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.
- 6.6 Transnet will publish the outcome of this RFP in the National Treasury e-tender portal and Transnet website with 10 days after the award has been finalised. Respondents are required to check the National Treasury e-tender Portal and Transnet website for the results of the tender process. All unsuccessful bidders have a right to request Transnet to furnish individual reasons for their bid not being successful. This requested must be directed to the contact person stated in the SBD 1 form.

7 CONFIDENTIALITY

All information related to this RFP is to be treated with strict confidence. In this regard Respondents are required to certify that they have acquainted themselves with the Non-Disclosure Agreement. All information related to a subsequent contract, both during and after completion thereof, will be treated with strict confidence. Should the need however arise to divulge any information related to this RFP or the subsequent contract, written approval must be obtained from Transnet.

8 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Service provider**] shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

9 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

10 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFP and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 10.1 modify the RFP's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- 10.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- 10.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 10.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 10.5 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;



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- 10.6 split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 10.7 cancel the bid process;
- 10.8 validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;
- 10.9 request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;
- 10.10 not accept any changes or purported changes by the Respondent to the bid rates after the closing date and/or after the award of the business, unless the contract specifically provided for it;
- 10.11 to cancel the contract and/request that National Treasury place the Respondent on its Database of Restricted Suppliers for a period not exceeding 10 years, on the basis that a contract was awarded on the strength of incorrect information furnished by the Respondent or on any other basis recognised in law;
- 10.12 to award the business to the next ranked bidder, provided that he/she is still prepared to provide the required Goods at the quoted price, should the preferred bidder fail to sign or commence with the contract within a reasonable period after being requested to do so. Under such circumstances, the validity of the bids of the next ranked bidder(s) will be deemed to remain valid, irrespective of whether the outcome of the tender has been published the outcome of the bid process on the National Treasury e-tender Portal and Transnet website. Bidders may therefore be requested to advise whether they would still be prepared to provide the required Goods at their quoted price.

Note that Transnet will not reimburse any Respondent for any preparatory costs or other work performed in connection with its Proposal, whether or not the Respondent is awarded a contract.

11 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. A material deviation from the Standard terms or conditions could result in disqualification.

12 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Respondents must register on the CSD prior to submitting their bids. Business may not be awarded to a Respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD.

13 TAX COMPLIANCE

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).



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It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit bids.

Where Consortia / Joint Ventures / Sub-contractors are involved, each party must be registered on the Central Supplier Database and their tax compliance status will be verified through the Central Supplier Database.





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SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1 BACKGROUND

Halfweg (Loop 10) is a remote depot situated at approximately 446,3 kilometres from Saldanha and the **nearestsmall town is Brandvlei**, which an approximately 90 kilometres distance.

Halfweg is currently utilised as a Crew book off facility for Transnet Freight rail and provides basic accommodation and meals to Operations and Rail Network maintenance personnel.

This facility also caters for recovery teams in the event of any rail safety related incidents (derailments, networkfailures etc.).

The Transnet Freight Rail kitchen staff compliment based at this facility compromise as follows:

- 4 x Cooks;
- 5 x Waiters.

Transnet Freight Rail does not have the expertise to manage the Kitchen on a 24/7 basis, the decision wastaken to outsource the facility.

2 EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

Whereas Transnet is seeking a Service Provider/s to manage the Kitchen and supply meals at Halfweg on a 24/7 basis, it also seeks to improve its current processes for providing these Goods to its end user communitythroughout its locations.

The selected Service Provider(s) must share in the mission and business objectives of Transnet. These mutualgoals will be met by meeting contractual requirements and new challenges in an environment of teamwork, joint participation, flexibility, innovation and open communications. In this spirit of partnership, Transnet and its Service Provider(s) will study the current ways they do business to enhance current practices and support processes and systems. Such a partnership will allow Transnet to reach higher levels of quality, service and profitability.

Specifically, Transnet seeks to benefit from this partnership in the following ways:

- 2.1 Transnet must receive reduced cost of acquisition and improved service benefits resulting from the Supplier/Service provider's economies of scale and streamlined service processes.
- 2.2 Transnet must achieve appropriate availability that meets user needs while reducing costs for bothTransnet and the chosen Supplier/Service provider(s).
- 2.3 Transnet must receive proactive improvements from the Supplier/Service provider with respect tosupply/provision of Goods/Services and related processes.
- 2.4 Transnet's overall competitive advantage must be strengthened by the chosen Supplier/Serviceprovider's leading edge technology and service delivery systems.
- 2.5 Transnet end users must be able to rely on the chosen Supplier/Service provider's personnel for service enquiries, recommendations and substitutions.
- 2.6 Transnet must reduce costs by streamlining its acquisition of Goods/Services, including managed serviceprocesses on a Group basis.



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3 SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1.1 The preferred service provider will be required to manage the kitchen and supply of meals on a 24/7basis. This is a 24/7 business and supervision is required on a daily basis (including public holidays).
- 3.1.2 Existing staff (cooks and waiters) will remain Transnet employees but will support the service provider interms of the outsourcing agreement and the service provider must provide on the job training on a continuous basis in food preparation and kitchen management skills to the Transnet employees for the duration of the contract.
- 3.1.3 Transnet Freight Rail, is serving approximately 140 meals a day to their operations and rail network employees.
- 3.1.4 It will be required from the service provider to have a supervisor/manager on duty 24/7 to provide the required supervision to the TFR kitchen staff.
- 3.1.5 The preferred service provider must be prepared to cater for the following: all dietary preferences, religions, cultural and etc.
- 3.1.6 The meals including beverages served will be of high quality and prepared in a clean and hygienic mannerin accordance with all food safety regulations in line with regulation r364 as stipulated by the department of health.
- 3.1.7 The service provider must ensure that the food safety principles and practices are adhered to at all timesto prevent food contamination that might lead to food poisoning after consumption of affected food substances.
- 3.1.8 In addition to the catering technical knowledge, the service provider must have the minimum requirementknowledge of food safety (e.g. must have obtained the relevant qualification)
- 3.1.9 TFR have the right to do food safety audits at the Halfweg facility as and when required.
- 3.1.10 At times it will be required from the service provider to cater for recovery teams in the event of any rail safety related incident close to the facility (derailments, network failures etc.)
- 3.1.11 Preparation of snacks, coffee and other beverages to acceptable food industry standards in line with regulation r364 as required by the department of health, whilst also ensuring that no food preparation, other than specified, takes place on the premises.
- 3.1.12 The contractor is prohibited to use Transnet freight rail kitchen for private catering.
- 3.1.13 The provision of catering service shall be limited to only Transnet freight rail employees as stipulated, unless otherwise authorise by Transnet Freight Rail management.
- 3.1.14 This scope of work shall be undertaken in the manner stated in this document as well as the service levelagreement.
- 3.1.15 The service provider shall maintain a stock of consumables in the stores, at his own risk, provided that all local council by laws and the occupational health and safety act are adhered to.
- 3.1.16 Tender prices will be reviewed 12 monthly of the contract period. All increases are subject



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to Transnet Freight Rail's approval, prior to implementation. Management fees will be fix for 12 month period and only escalation base on CPI (consumer price index).

- 3.1.17 Transnet freight rail shall not be responsible or liable for any loss or damage to the service provider's stock of consumables and equipment stored on Transnet Freight Rail's premises.

3.12 Number of meals

- 3.12.2 This number is given in good faith as a guide only. TFR does not guarantee this number and will notcompensate the Contractor for any number of meals sold less than this number.
- 3.12.3 TFR will render payment on the actual number of meals sold (as opposed to actual number of meals prepared)to permanent employees of TFR only.
- 3.12.4 Transnet will provide the number of meals, as close as possible to the actual number of meals, 24 hours inadvance.

The penalty for not ensuring the correct number and quality of meals, and are produced in accordance with the 24 hour schedule will be calculated as a percentage of the requested meals.

3.13 Transnet Freight Rail shall:

- 3.13.2 Provide appropriate information as and when required and only in situations where it is required by the ServiceProvider to fulfil their duties; by means of raising a Purchase Order (PO).
- 3.13.3 Not accept responsibility for any damages suffered by the Service Provider or their personnel for the duration of the contract.
- 3.13.4 Not accept any responsibility of accounts/expenses incurred by the Service Provider that was not agreed uponby the contracting parties.
- 3.13.5 Provide a storage facility for equipment and materials.

3.14 Service Provider shall:

- 3.14.8 Provide all personnel working under this contract with uniforms, which state the name of the Service Providerand that can be clearly identified from other Service Providers, Transnet Freight Rail personnel, etc. TransnetFreight Rail reserves the right to order the immediate removal of a staff member that does not adhere to this arrangement.
- 3.14.9 Provide all personnel working under this contract with adequate and appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and clothing and to ensure these items are worn at all times.
- 3.14.10 Ensure that Transnet Freight Rail is informed of any removal and replacement of personnel. For security reasons, Transnet Freight Rail reserves the right to vet all personnel working under this contract.
- 3.14.11 Demonstrate his modus operandi to Transnet Freight Rail with regards to supplies delivered to site.
- 3.14.12 Provide an on-site manager, available at all times.
- 3.14.13 Issue and circulate weekly and daily menus to TFR Hostel Manager.

3.15 OTHER REQUIREMENTS

The following functions will form part of the contract:

- 3.15.1 On the job training for Transnet Freight Rail kitchen personnel; -
- 3.15.2 Weekly Food Safety Awareness workshop / training session (4 to 5 hour)
- 3.15.3 Proof of a hazard analysis critical control point (HACCP) certificate at any of their establish sites.

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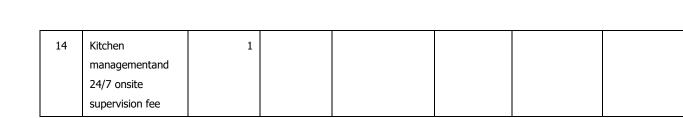

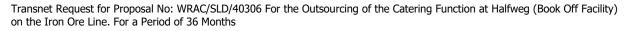

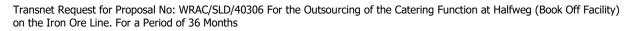

- (I) **"rand value"** means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties.
- (m) "Specific goals" means targeted advancement areas or categories of persons or groups either previously disadvantaged or falling within the scope of the Reconstruction and Development Programme identified by Transnet to be given preference in allocation of procurement contracts in line with section 2(1) of the PPPFA.

3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1 THE 80/20 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20

$$Ps = 80 \left(1 - \frac{Pt - P\min}{P\min} \right)$$

Where

Ps = Points scored for comparative price of bid under consideration

Pt = Comparative price of bid under consideration

Pmin = Comparative price of lowest acceptable bid

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- 4.4 Tertiary Institutions and Public Entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 4.5 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the bid documents that such a bidder intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a bidder qualifies for, unless the intended sub-contractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
- 4.6 A person awarded a contract may not sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is sub-contracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
- 4.7 Bidders are to note that the rules pertaining to B-BBEE verification and other B-BBEE requirements may be changed from time to time by Transnet or regulatory bodies such as National Treasury or the DTI. It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that his/her bid complies fully with all B-BBEE requirements at the time of the submission of the bid.
