No letters of award or purchase orders will be accepted; only reference letters with contactable details will be accepted, and there must be on the letterhead of the company providing the referral.</li> <li>Is any valid COIDA accepted? Only the COIDA mentioned in the mandatory documents will be accepted.</li> <li>Are bidders allowed to walk inside the depots without PPE? No, bidders are not allowed to do so. It is indicated in the RFP documents that bidders must have their PPE for the site briefing meetings in all areas.</li> <li>Are bidders who didn't attend other site briefing areas allowed to bid? It was clarified that this meeting is not intended to disqualify any bidder; rather, it is a clarification meeting for the advertised bid.</li> <li>Bidders inquired about Section 4 of the pricing schedule.</li> <li>It was clarified to the bidders that Section 4 must include the total of all costs listed in Annexure H, quoted for each year over the three-year period, and should provide escalations for Year 1, Year 2, and Year 3 based on the applicable indices.
