 - reject any Quotation which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
 - disqualify Quotations submitted after the stated submission deadline;
 - not necessarily accept the lowest priced Quotation or an alternative bid;
 - place an order in connection with this Quotation at any time after the RFQ's closing date;
 - award only a portion of the proposed goods / services which are reflected in the scope of this RFQ;
 - split the award of the order/s between more than one Supplier/Service Provider should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;

10 Legal review

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

11 Security clearance

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the goods and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

12 National Treasury's Central Supplier Database

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Transnet is required to ensure that price quotations are invited and accepted from prospective bidders listed on the CSD. Business may not be awarded to a respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD. For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 Form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

13 Tax Compliance

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit bids.



1.5 STEP FIVE: Post Tender Negotiations (if applicable)

- Respondents are to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market-related. In this regard, Transnet reserves the right to engage in PTN with the view to achieving a market-related price or to cancel the tender. Negotiations will be done in a sequential manner i.e.:
 - first negotiate with the highest ranked bidder or cancel the bid, should such negotiations fail,
 - o negotiate with the 2nd and 3rd ranked bidders (if required) in a sequential manner.
- In the event of any Respondent being notified of such short-listed/preferred bidder status, his/her bid, as well as any subsequent negotiated best and final offers (BAFO), will automatically be deemed to remain valid during the negotiation period and until the ultimate award of business.

- is not undergoing a process of being restricted by Transnet or other state institution that Transnet may be aware of,
- can, as necessary and in relation to the proposed contract, demonstrate that he or she possesses the
 professional and technical qualifications, professional and technical competence, financial resources,
 equipment and other physical facilities, managerial capability, reliability, experience and reputation,
 expertise and the personnel, to perform the contract,
- has the legal capacity to enter into the contract
- is not insolvent, in receivership, under Business Rescue as provided for in chapter 6 of the Companies Act, 2008, bankrupt or being wound up, has his affairs administered by a court or a judicial officer, has suspended his business activities, or is subject to legal proceedings in respect of any of the foregoing,
- complies with the legal requirements, if any, stated in the tender data and
- is able, in the option of the employer to perform the contract free of conflicts of interest.
- all Risks identified during a risk assessment exercise/probity check (which may be conducted by an authorised third party) that would be done to assess all risks, including but not limited to:

1. Project Overview

Introduction

TPT's core business is the handling of both bulk and dry bulk commodities, either entering or exiting via the Richards Bay harbour premises. The cargo is transported using either mobile fleet or a network of conveyors.

To handle high volumes and accurately monitor the amount of cargo brought in or taken out of the port, the port requires reliable weighing system of conveyor belts scales in the port. Which are in different routes and different conveyor belts within the Port.

TPT technical team requires the repairs of 4 existing belt scales namely, O2(Weigher 1 & Weigher 2) and O3(Weigher 1 and Weigher 2), *refer to Appendix A*

2. Site Location

The site is located on the premises of Transnet Port Terminal (TPT) at the Richards Bay Port. The contract will service belt scales that are at both at the DBT and PRT Terminals.

4. Additional requirements

The vendor is required to:

- Clean and service all four cale.
- Align and balance all four scales.
- Check and verify statuses of all I/O being used.
- Inspect field wiring and loose connection (tight loose wires if any)
- Manually test and calculate belt speed- compare it with the speed sensor feedback on the digitizer.
- Span Calibration perform Span Calibration with known certified Weight.
 Record all changes and results.
- Inspect and replace any faulty load cells (vendor to supply 4 loadcells).
- Speed Sensor Coupling Inspect for tightness, alignment & corrosion.
- Cable Integrity between scale and substation F Visual & ohm check (corrosion, moisture, deterioration).
- Track deviation of scale with draft of four vessel and apply correction.
- Check and current any alarms/faults and submit the report to TPT rep.
- Submit calibration report to TPT rep.
- The methodologies of the contractor should increase operations efficiency and maintenance is to be preventive.
