The project plan has to be clearly show the lead time for completing the maintenance from issue of the PO, execution, equipment hand over to TPT and submission of reports.	Lead time of 6 weeks or less: 35 points Lead time of 7 to 8 weeks: 15 points Lead time more than 8 weeks: 0 points
	2. Company's Track Record	Company to provide at least two reference letters or official orders from customers who they have done work on Medium voltage equipment or switchgear within the last 2 years.	2 or more references: 35 points Less than 2 references: 0 points
	3. Compliance to Scope of Work	The supplier is required to submit a signed letter stating whether they will fully comply with the scope of work.	Letter of full compliance submitted: 30 Points No letter of full compliance submitted: 0 Points

Threshold: Bids achieving a score of less than 80% will be disqualified.
