- Carry out full internal and external visual inspection (welding, pitting, corrosion, etc.) PER 11.
- Eliminate any piping, valves or fittings connected to the vessel that are not needed for test.
- Blank off the vessel and fill it up with water.
- Carry out Ultrasonic wall thickness measurements.
- Inspection body to bring their own SANAS Calibrated Gauges (sticker-on gauge with valid calibration dates), Thickness Meter and Pressure Pump.
- Attach pressure pump and at least one SANAS calibrated pressure gauge that is still within the calibrated dates, on top of the vessel.

Safety valve and Gauge to be set to the correct KPA's in relation to that specific vessel. Gauge to have a SANS sticker with serial number, calibration date and next calibration date.**

- AIA inspector to give a written inspection report (work done, authorization to use a vessel or not) on the day of inspection.
- If Air Receiver is situated outside and the paint is in a bad condition, paint it with the same colour.
